Female Uro Genital Problems which occur in ladies who have urinary incontinence, prolapsed of the uterus, pelvic inflammatory disease, chronic urinary tract infection, persistent cystitis and tuberculosis of the pelvis with symptoms which include burning micturition, low backache, dyspareunia, pelvic pain, fever and frequency of micturition and involuntary passage of urine.

Diagnosis and treatment are evidence based, routine urine test, sonography, ct scan of pelvis, urodynamic studies for stress incontinence etc. Treatment will depend on the investigation findings and clinical status of the patient. It is important to complete the course of the treatment. Very often people stop medication once they start feeling better. The pathogens then develop resistance to drugs and infections recurs.

An urinary tract infection (UTI) happens when bacteria, and sometimes viruses and other germs, get into your urinary tract system. An UTI can affect your kidneys, ureters, bladder and urethra. UTI is treatable therefore it is advised to see your doctor if you have any symptoms. If UTIs aren't treated, they can become harmful.
